# Home Health

Home health is a wide range of services that can be given in your home for an illness or injury to help you regain or maintain your highest level of ability.

Home health includes skilled nursing care on a part-time or intermittent basis and provides services and care that can only be performed by a nurse.

- Wound care
- Client and caregiver education
- IV or nutrition therapy

Physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy for as long as your doctor says you need it.

- Exercise to regain movement and strength so you can do usual daily activities by yourself
- Exercise to regain and strengthen speech skills

Home care aide for personal care assistance needs such as bathing or skin care.



# Hospice

Hospice is a special kind of care that focuses on the quality of life for people with a terminal diagnosis.

It provides support for both the client AND family, including bereavement services for grieving families for up to 13 months.

Your care team works together with you and your family to ensure your comfort and dignity.

Anyone with a life expectancy of 6 months or less is eligible for hospice, and services can continue as long as you are eligible.

Services include symptom and pain control, assistance with bathing or other personal cares, emotional support, bereavement support, spiritual care, and more.

Hospice is most beneficial when the client and family can receive care early to take advantage of all the great benefits it has to offer.

Hospice care is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurances. No one is ever turned away due to inability to pay.
